BRIEF HISTORY OF JNSC

The inauguration of the Junior Naval Staff College (JNSC) at Naval and Maritime Academy became a reality on 07th March 2005, accomplishing a long felt need for the middle level Staff Officers of the Sri Lanka Navy. The first and second JNSC courses were conducted in June and October 2005. However the third course was conducted after a gap of nearly 03 years.

After another vacuum of approximately three years, the fourth Junior Naval Staff Course commenced on 07th February 2011 and continued thereafter. The level of the course has been elevated by awarding the Postgraduate Diploma in Defense Management by General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University from 7th Junior Naval Staff Course onwards. Opportunity has also been extended to the officers of sister services to join JNSC since the 7th course.

The 31st Junior Naval Staff Course comprising 19 officers including a lady officer from Indian Navy and a officer from Sri Lanka Air Force, will culminate on 14th November 2022.

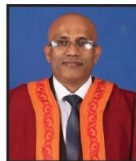
