## **NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)**

## 1. **RULES**

- a. The regatta will be governed by the rules as define in the racing rules of sailing 2025-2028 (RRS).
- b. The equipment rules of sailing and current class rule of the Laser /Enterprises classes will apply.
- c. If there is any ambiguity of media of communication, the English language will take precedence among the participants.
- d. Appendix P of RRS (Special procedures for rule 42) will apply.

## 2. **ELIGIBILTY AND ENTRY**

- a. The event will be conducted in Laser Radial and Enterprise class boats.
- b. The regatta is an invitational event and invitations are extended to naval academies of friendly countries. Regatta is designed only for the Officer Under Trainees (OUTs) who are training at the respective academies.
- c. The invited academies may participate with a team of four (04) members including three (03) Officer Cadets/Midshipmen as participants one (01) for Laser Class, two (02) for Enterprises Class and one (01) as the OIC- cum- Coach (a serving Officer of the rank of Lt/LCdr).
- d. Officer Under Trainees up to the rank of Sub Lieutenants who are currently undergoing in-house training programmes will be permitted to participate and all participants are to be below 25 years of age on the date commencement of the regatta.
- e. Entries should be sent by e-mail to <a href="mailto:nma.commandant@gmail.com">nma.commandant@gmail.com</a> with a copy to the Director Naval Foreign Cooperation, <a href="mailto:nhqdnfc@gmail.com">nhqdnfc@gmail.com</a> at the earliest. The last date for receipt of entries will be 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025.

## 3. **FEES**

There will be no entry or charter fees for the event.

## 4. **<u>FORMAT</u>**

- a. Regatta will be conducted in two (02) categories, namely, "Cup Championship" and "Open Championship". The participants who fulfil the prerequisites under paragraph 2, 'c' and 'd' are allowed to participate in the "Cup Championship" and those who are not fulfilling the prerequisites of paragraph 2, 'c' and 'd' are allowed to participate in "Open Championship" representing respective academies.
- b. The event will have six (06) single series of fleet races for each class of boats. Both classes of boats will be raced separately as fleets. The combined score of all the best five (05) races will determine the overall class standings.
- c. Both Laser and Enterprise class combined standings will determine the "Cup Championship".
- d. Only Laser class boats will be utilized for the "Open Championship".

# 5. **SCHEDULE**

b. The number of races may be reduced in case of unfavourable weather conditions.

## 6. **BOATS AND EQUIPMENT**

- a. All boats and associated sailing gear will be supplied by the organizing authority.
- b. Participants may carry their own boats of identical/ similar class.
- b. Competitors may use their own control lines and foils.
- c. Buoyancy aids will be provided.

# 7. <u>SAILING INSTRUCTIONS</u>

Sailing instructions will be provided on completion of registration on 20th August 2025.

## 8. **VENUE**

The venue for the event will be **Sandy Bay** at **Trincomalee**.

# 9. **COURSE**

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward, trapezoid or any other configuration as may be described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10. **FINISH**

All participants must finish the race within 10 minutes after the first competitor of the relevant class crosses the finish line.

## 11. **SCORING**

- a. The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A, will apply to all races.
- b. Three (03) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- c. When three (03) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of the race score.
- d. When from four (04) to six (06) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of the race scores excluding the worst score.

## 12. **SUPPORT BOATS**

No support boats are permitted and spectator boats will be organized/ arranged by the organizing authority.

## 13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications. This restriction also applies to mobile cell phones.

## 14. **PRIZES**

- a. Certificates will be awarded to all participants.
- b. The top three (03) participants of both Laser and Enterprise classes will be awarded individual medals. The top three (03) teams (combined score of Laser and Enterprise class) will be awarded team medals and the highest ranked team will be awarded the "Commandant's Cup" Trophy.
- c. The top three (03) participants of the "Open Championship" will be awarded individual medals and the highest ranked team will be awarded the "Open Championship" Trophy and medals.
- d. The trophies awarded are rolling trophies and are to be returned to the OA upon the completion of the awarding ceremony. Replicas will be awarded to the winning teams to carry with them.
